

### THE SUITES

- + 4 rooms - one bed, one bath
- + 1 family room - two bed, two bath
- + Soaking tub with river views
- + Double or twin configuration
- + Fans in bedrooms
- + Solar power, British three pin plugs in main lounge
- + No wifi and phone signal
- + Main lodge - dining area, lounge, bar, campfire and pool

- + Open 20 May to 7 November
- + Children of all ages welcome by prior arrangement
- + 2.5 hr game drive transfer from Mfuwe

Wild dog sightings pick up in late October and November.

## GREAT ALL SEASON

- + Epic leopard and lion sightings
- + River crossings of large herds of elephants
- + Wildlife photography - still a wild land devoid of crowds makes for great photographic opportunities.

The start of the walking safari season, which runs from May to November.




September to November is best for seeing the iconic carmine bee-eaters.




Peak season for our signature Sleepout Under the Stars is July to October.

Lion sightings pick up as the bush gets drier.






# WALKING ROUTES
