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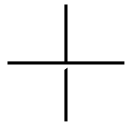

Situated deep in the park on the ephemeral Luwi River, Time + Tide Luwi is wonderfully remote, with no other camps for miles around. Tranquillity envelops this camp, creating a haven that allows you to reconnect with nature in a meaningful way. Nestled in a grove of ancient mahogany trees, the tents are designed to fully immerse guests into the bush experience. From the comfort of your open air lounge, watch the diverse wildlife wandering by on the grassy floodplains. Listen to the hippos bellowing in the nearby lagoon and breathe in the heady aroma of African jasmine drifting past on a cool breeze. Sit back and let the peace of this place wash over you.

- + Main lodge - dining area, lounge, library, bar and campfire

October and November are great for predator action as animals gather at dwindling water sources.

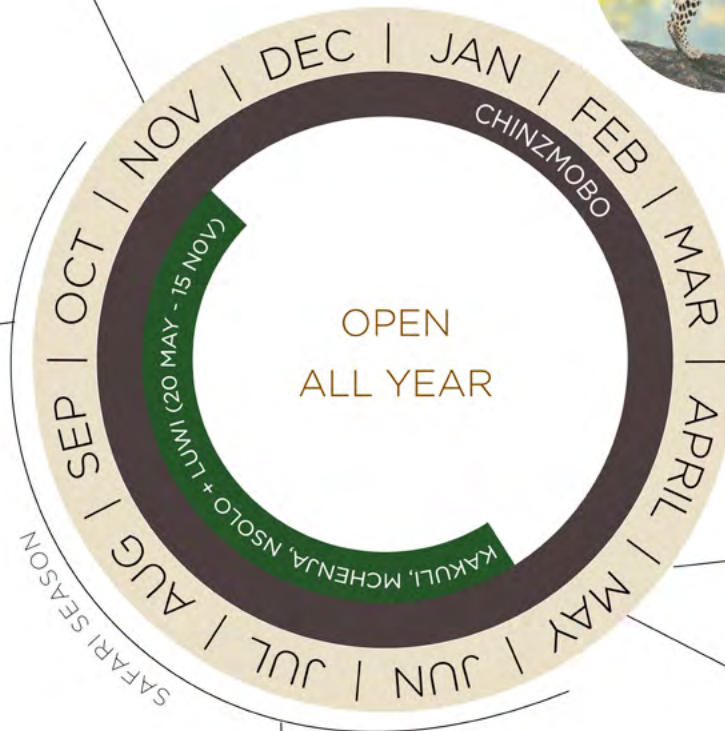


September to November is the best time of year to see the iconic carmine bee-eaters nesting in the dry riverbanks.

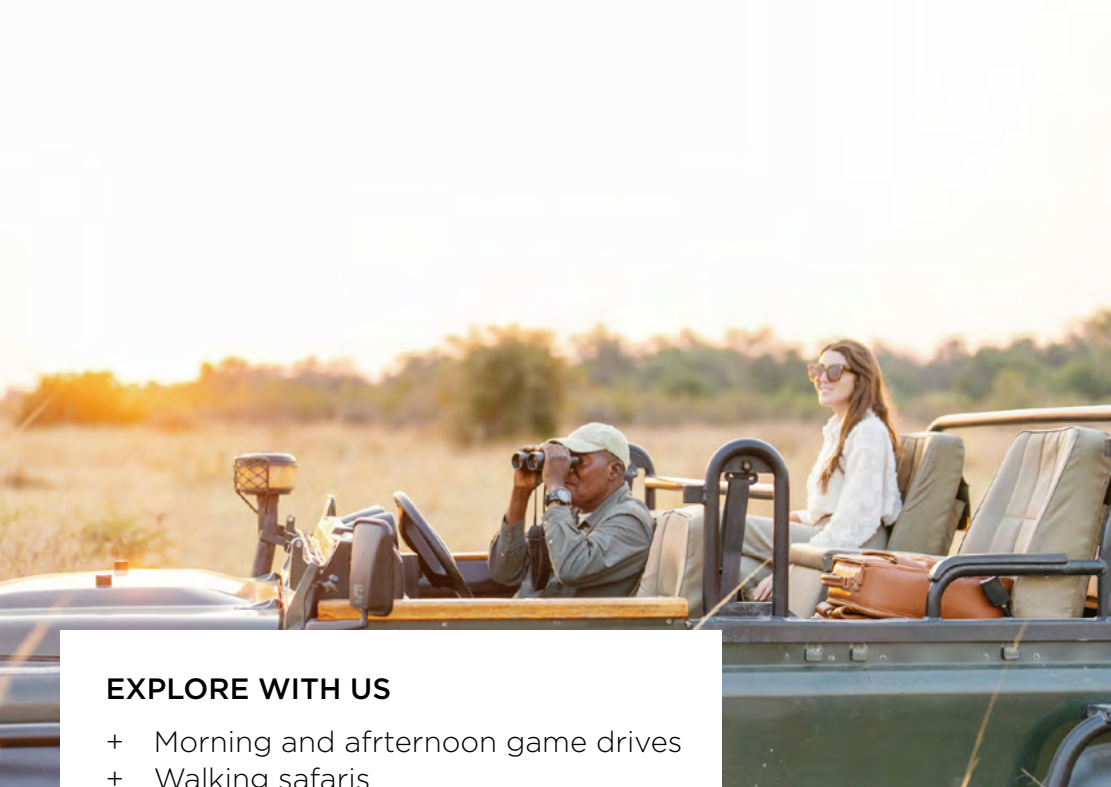
July to October is peak season for our Sleepout Under the Stars.

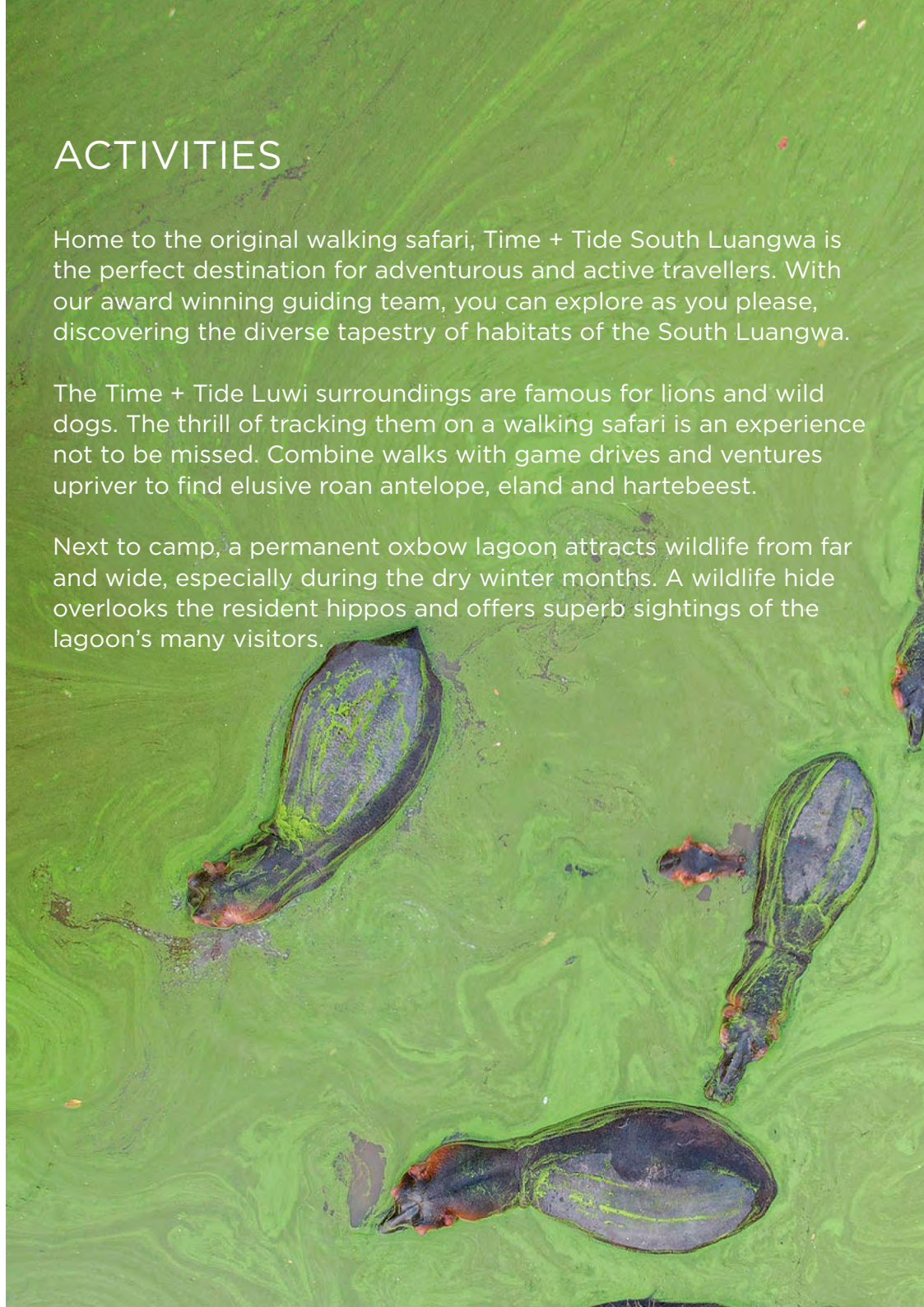


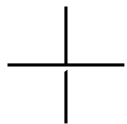
ACTIVITIES

Next to camp, a permanent oxbow lagoon attracts wildlife from far and wide, especially during the dry winter months. A wildlife hide overlooks the resident hippos and offers superb sightings of the lagoon's many visitors.

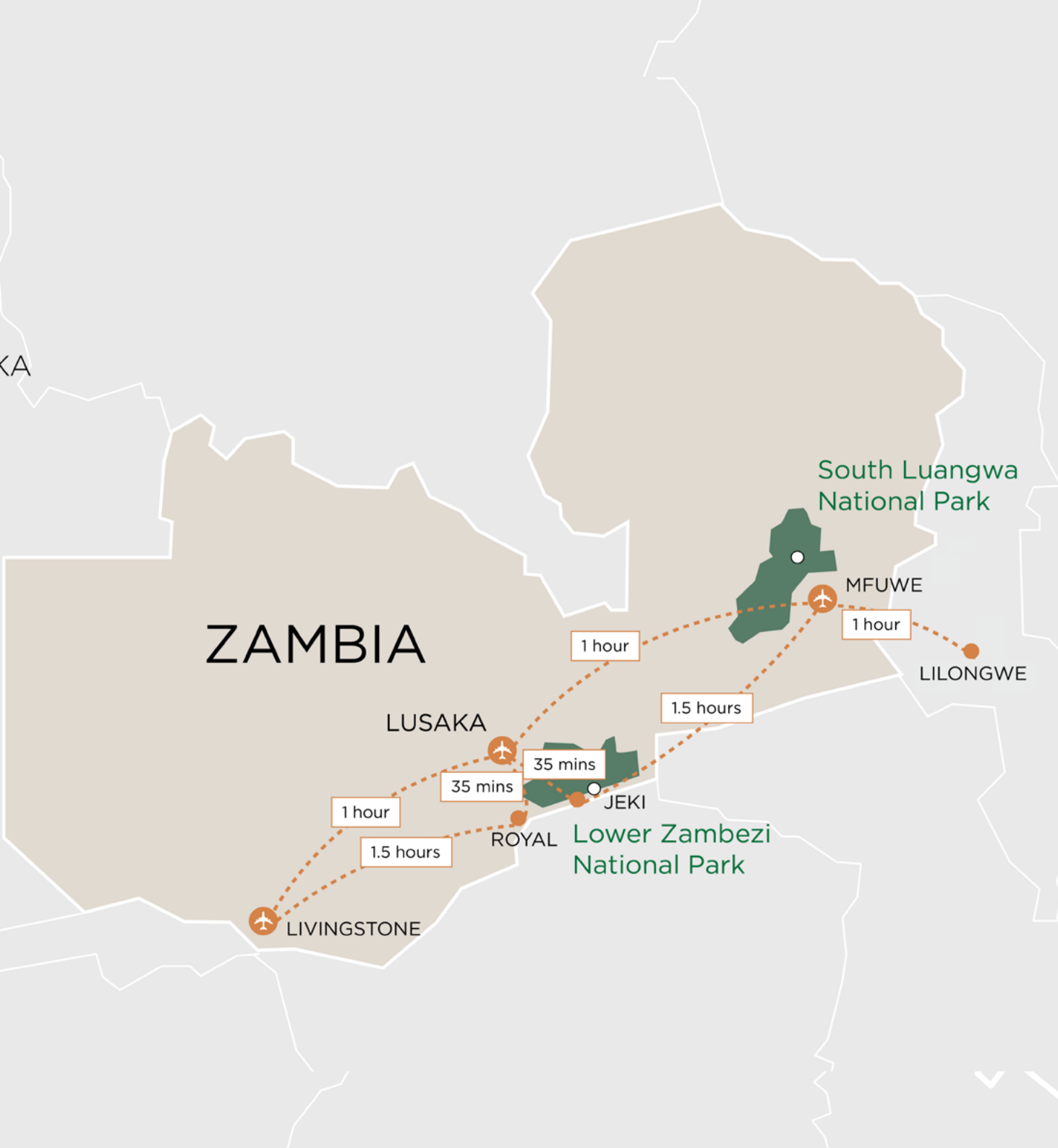

Kakuli to Mchenja - 7km (approx 2 hours)

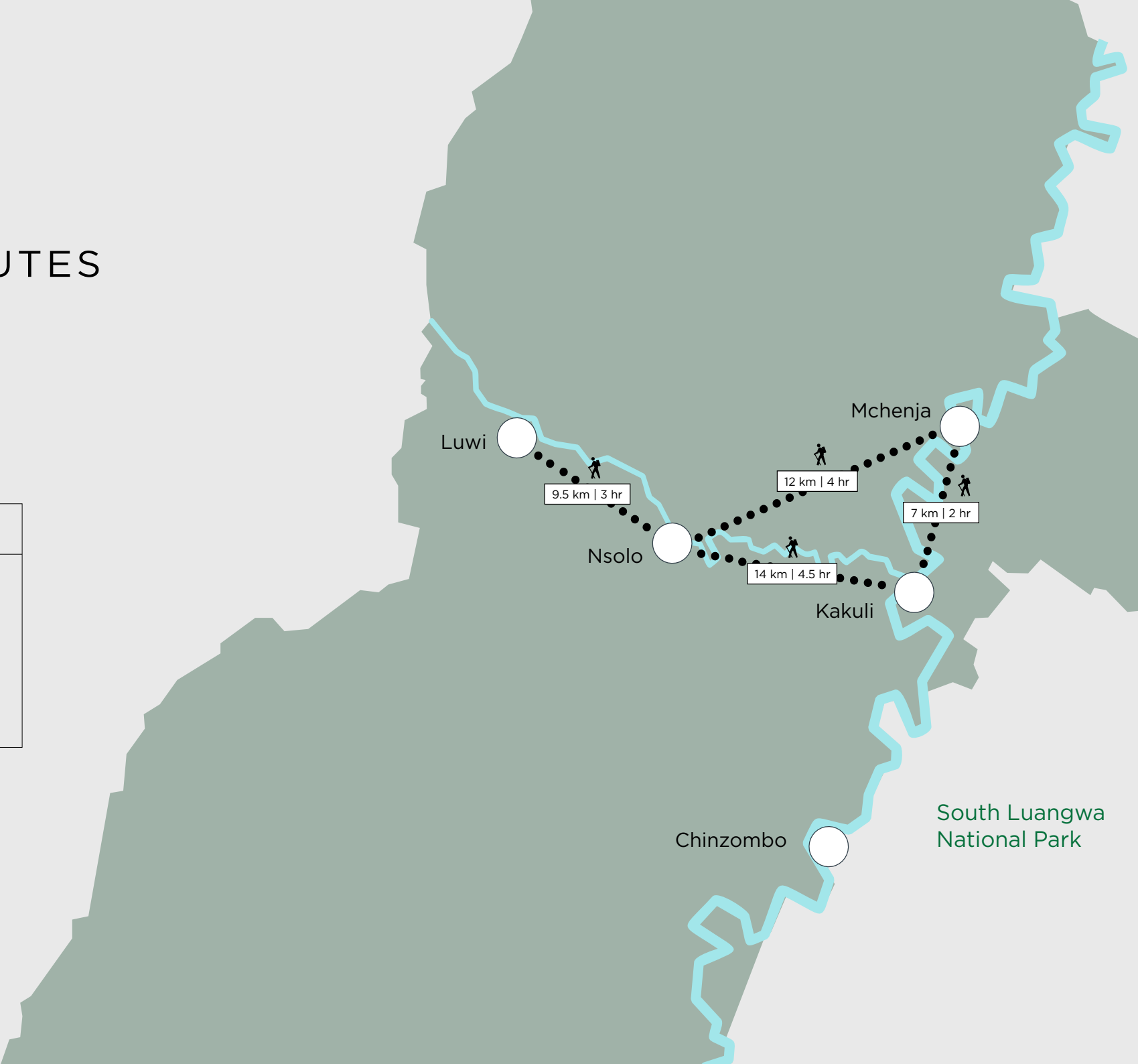
