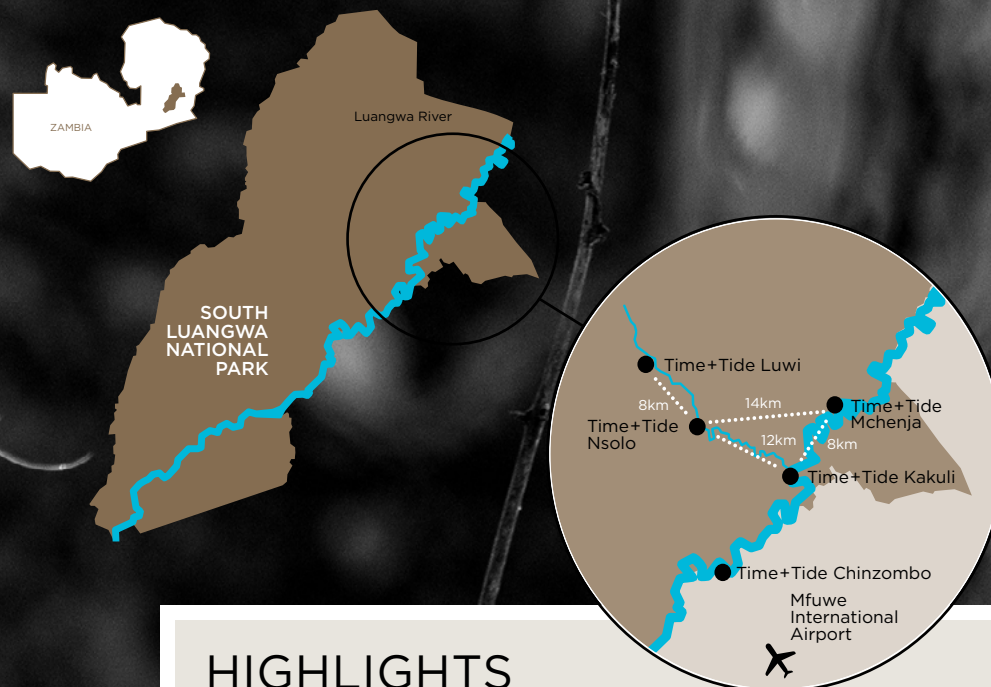

Still wholly wild and devoid of crowds, South Luangwa National Park is a destination for the modern day explorers seeking an authentic experience. Renowned for its world class predator action, the park has been nicknamed the ‘Valley of the Leopard’ thanks to prolific sightings of this elusive big cat. Diverse habitat supports large herds of elephants, countless bird species, abundant plains game and endangered species, such as wild dogs. Immerse into this remarkable destination and reconnect with nature in a meaningful way. Stop. Touch the earth. Breathe the wild air.

October to April is the best time of year to see endangered wild dogs.

October and November are great for predator action as animals gather at dwindling water sources.

Many migrant bird species are still enjoying the abundance of South Luangwa.

September to November is the best time of year to see the iconic carmine bee-eaters nesting in the dry riverbanks.

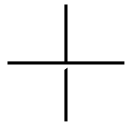
July to October is peak season for our Sleepout Under the Stars.

The walking safari season starts in earnest, running from May to mid November.

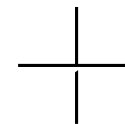

The South Luangwa, often called the Valley of the Leopard, is famed for big cat sightings and its high wildlife densities. Lions, wild dog, elephants, buffalo and plains game thrive here, alongside endemic species like Thornicroft's giraffe, Crawshay's zebra and Cookson's wildebeest.

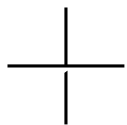
SLEEPOUT UNDER THE STARS

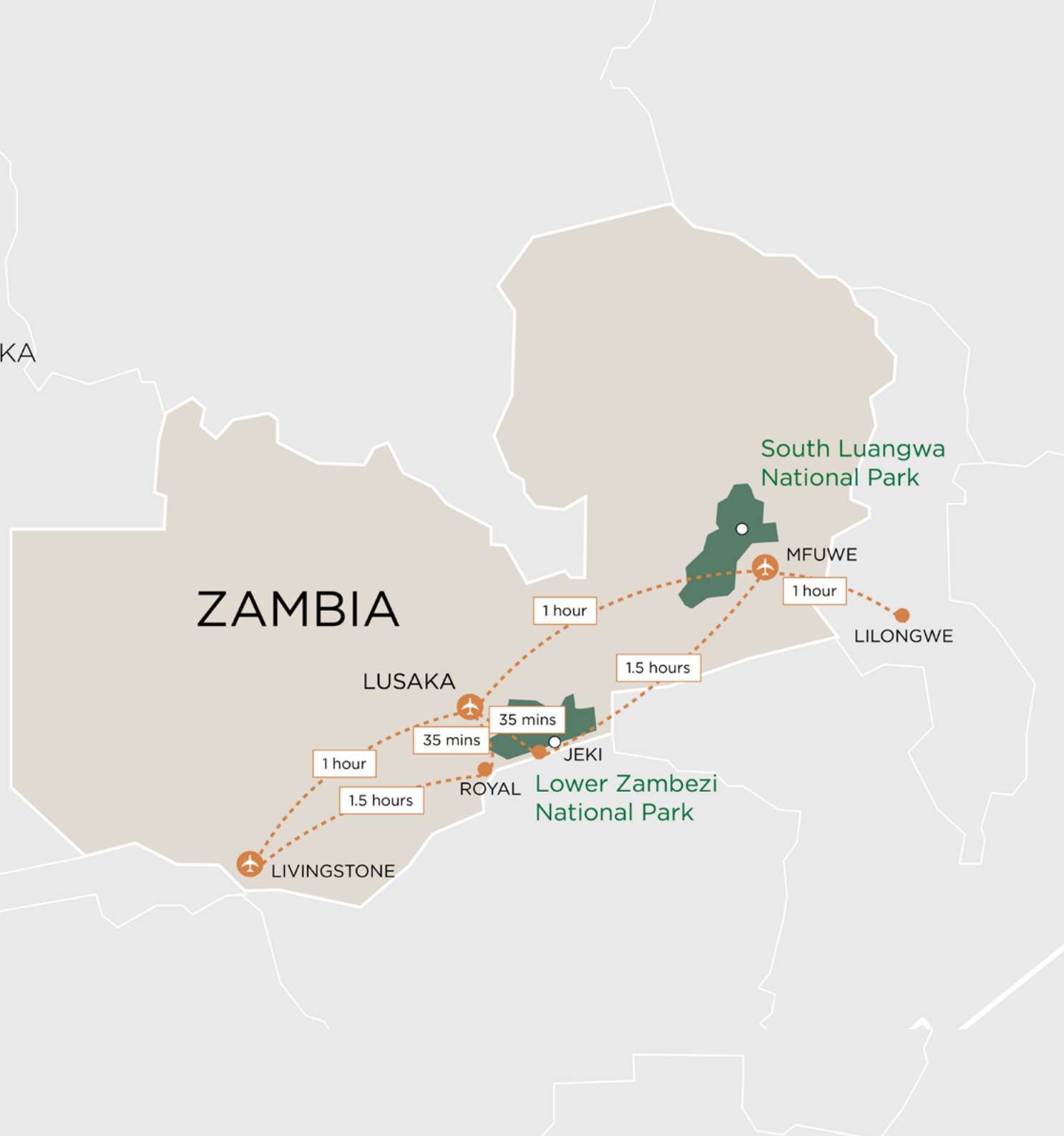


